This drama, 190 years old, was staged in 1825. Since then it is one of the most famed themes for stages, films and TV. Kaidan means horror story but the reason why Yotsuya Kaidan has been and still is so popular is not just a scary play but it depicts the complicated human relationships among attractive characters on the elaborate stage production. Zenshinza presents this entertaining ghost play for the first time in 34 years. This may be a good opportunity to be an audience of the drama having a long history.
